WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND LIABILITY RELEASE

In consideration of acceptance as a participant in Girls Summer College Tour (the "Event"), the undersigned participant (the "Participant") and Participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) agree to the following Waiver of Claims and Liability Release (the "Waiver and Release")

Assumption of Risk: I/We understand the nature of the Event and are fully aware of the risks of unexpected injuries, illness (ex: communicable diseases such as MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19) damage or other loss that may result in the Participant's attendance and participation in the Event. **I/We freely assume all responsibility of all such risks** to the Participant, **including the risk of negligence** by other participants, Distinctly His Ministries, any of the organizers or volunteers of the Event, any hosting organizations, their staff, or any of the other Released Parties defined below.

Release: I/We hereby release from liability, waive any claims against, forever discharge and hold harmless Distinctly His Ministries, their affiliates, managers, members, agents, attorneys, staff, sponsors, partners, heirs, representatives, successors and assigns, volunteers associated with the Event, hosting organizations of the Event, the organizers of the Event and each of their respective officials, owners, partners, sponsors, directors, officers, trustees, members, employees, representatives, and agents, and the other participants in the Event (collectively called "Released Parties") of and from any and all claims, present and future that may be made myself/us, my/our family, estate, heirs, or assigns for **injuries, illness, disability, death**, property damage, attorneys fees, or other loss of any kind or nature that may be sustained in connection with the Participant's attendance at or participation in the Event or any activity surrounding the Event, including traveling to and from an event related to this Event, **whether arising from negligence of the Released Parties or otherwise**, to the fullest extent permitted by law. I/We further agree not to sue any of the Released Parties for any such claim.

Medical Treatment: In connection with any injury the Participant may sustain or other medical condition the Participant may experience during their participation in or attendance at the Event, we authorize any emergency first aid, medication, medical treatment or surgery deemed necessary by the attending medical and/or first aid personnel if Participant is unable to act on their own behalf. I/We further authorize the attending medical and/or first aid personnel to execute on behalf of the Participant any permission forms, consents or other appropriate documents relating to medical attention and to act on behalf of the Participant if the Participant's parent/legal guardian cannot immediately do so. **I/We agree to be financially responsible for any costs incurred as a result of medical care or treatment the Participant receives or requires.**

Publicity Release:

I/We authorize Distinctly His Ministries and/or other parties involved with the Event to produce, reproduce, broadcast and otherwise use the photographs, films, videotapes, recordings, digital images, and other depictions, likeness or images of Participant, in any media form, worldwide, in connection with Participant's attendance at or participation in the Event, or any other endeavor, without permission, notification, or compensation, for unlimited duration.

In the event that any damage to equipment or facilities occurs as a result of the Participant's willful actions, neglect or recklessness, I/we acknowledge and agree to be held liable for any and all costs associated with any actions of neglect or recklessness.

In the event that any portion of this Waiver and Release is declared invalid, unlawful, or otherwise unenforceable by final judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, we hereby agree that such determination shall not affect the balance of this Waiver and Release, but this Waiver and Release shall remain in full force and effect, as such invalid portion shall be deemed severable.

I/We have carefully read and voluntarily agree to this Waiver and Release and understand its full legal effect and do hereby agree that I/we will be bound by said Waiver and Release. I/We understand that we have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without any inducement.
